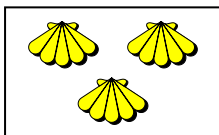

Harlow junior parkrun is a free, weekly, timed 2km run in Harlow Town Park that takes place every Sunday at 9am. It is for children aged 4-14.

Lots of children from High Wych school have already taken part and from their smiles as they are running, walking, skipping or hopping around the course it seems that they are enjoying themselves.
