

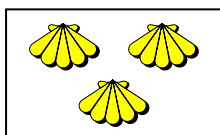

Webinar: Improving the way we manage our EHCP duties - "Making SEND Everybody's Business" - Thursday 23 May, 7pm - 8pm Online (Teams)

There is a lot of change happening to positively impact the experiences of families of children and young people with an EHCP. You may have heard already about the £7million of ongoing annual investment into our EHCP duties, and our 'Making SEND Everyone's Business' transformation programme.

Our Director of Inclusion and Skills will discuss how the money is being used and what this means for you if your child has, or is in the process of getting, an EHCP. Change takes time, and we hope families start to feel the positive impacts later this year.
