

We are looking forward to welcoming you to see the children's Nativity plays. They are all working hard on their singing.

Recordings will take place from Monday 12th so we need permission by Friday, 8th or your child will sadly not be able to take part in the recording. We currently have permission for all but a few Nursery parents.

Can I also remind you that we are only able to allocate two tickets per child. Younger siblings will count towards your allocation so please try and make alternative arrangements for them if at all possible.

Church service

We would like to invite you to the church on Thursday 14th December at 10am for our church service. The church will be running a café for parents after this service. Everyone is welcome to stay. Donations will be sent to local causes.

Christmas Dinner

This will take place on Wednesday 13th after we return from the Panto (oh yes it will!). All children in Reception and KS1 will be ordered a school dinner, as they are entitled to a meal every day, unless you inform us beforehand that they will be bringing a home packed lunch. If any children would like the Vegetable Wellington please let us know in advance otherwise we will order Turkey for them.

Children in KS2 will be able to choose on the day – either Turkey or Vegetable Wellington. However, it would be helpful to know in advance if your child would like the Vegetarian option. The cost will be £3.20 for KS2 children.

There will be no cold option on this day.

Nursery children staying all day can also choose a hot meal of Turkey or Vegetable Wellington at a cost of £2.70.
