

Welcome back!

We start our summer term with the lead up to SATs which begin on the 9th of May. They will take place over four days. After SATs we will have a trip to a Buddhist temple near Hemel Hempstead in connection with our RE topic. We will also be going to Crucial Crew which is a half day trip and helps prepare the children for the transition to secondary education. Details of these trips will follow.
