Scarlet Fever

There has been an increase in cases of Scarlet fever across Hertfordshire. Please follow the advice if you think you or your child may have the illness:

Scarlet fever is a mild illness with initial symptoms being a sore throat, headache and high temperature and a swollen tongue. This is followed by a pinkish rash. The fever clears up after about a week but you should visit your GP for a proper diagnosis and antibiotics.

Scarlet fever is highly contagious. Advice to limit the spread is: • if your child has scarlet fever keep them out of nursery or school for at least 24 hours after starting treatment

• adults should also stay off work for 24 hours

 $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze

wash hands with soap and water after using or throwing away tissues
avoid sharing cups, glasses, clothes, utensils, bed linen, towels or

• avoid sharing cups, glasses, clothes, utensils, bed linen, towers (baths with people with scarlet fever

Does your child love baking and fancy putting their skills to the test? Can they make the most mouth-watering shortbread; are they potty about pies or simply bonkers about bread?


