Sun cream

National Sun safe campaign

This is a reminder about ensuring that the children are adequately protected so they can enjoy the sun safely during the day.

- Please apply long lasting 30+ sunscreen before school
- Wear a legionnaire style hat which is safer to wear in the sun than a baseball cap. Reminder 'No hat, play in the shade'

Children may bring in a labelled **30+ factor** spray bottle in their book bags if

- they apply it only at the beginning of lunchtime, should they require it, to their face and exposed arms and legs.
- they do not share it with others as some contain nuts.

Any child misusing their sunscreen will have it taken away. All bottles are the responsibility of the child. Reception and Nursery children need to have a **spray option** only so that if the teacher needs to support them they can spray the sunscreen whilst the child rubs it in.

<u>Punctuality</u>

- Please be considerate to others


• DO NOT park in the road as traffic wardens will be about. You are welcome to stay for a picnic which will finish by 1 o'clock.
