Emergency Closure System


Please sign up to receive emergency messages relating to school closures if you haven't done so already. To sign up to receive our school's emergency messages you will need to use the following link member.everbridge.net/index/892807736725489.

This link will direct you to the "Sign Up" page where you should click on the "sign up" button located at the top right hand side of the page on the black strip and from there follow the instructions. It should take no more than 5 minutes to register and you can edit your information should it change at any time.

You can have 2 devices added for each communication type if you wish to add more than one - this means that in addition to adding your own mobile number and email address, you could include the mobile number and email address of a partner or a grandparent in your registration process. They too would then receive any messages in relation to your school's closure. Alternatively, interested parties could register themselves separately.

If you have children at more than one school you can register for those schools too in a single registration process by selecting all schools you have children at. Once signed up you will receive messages relating to the status of those schools.
